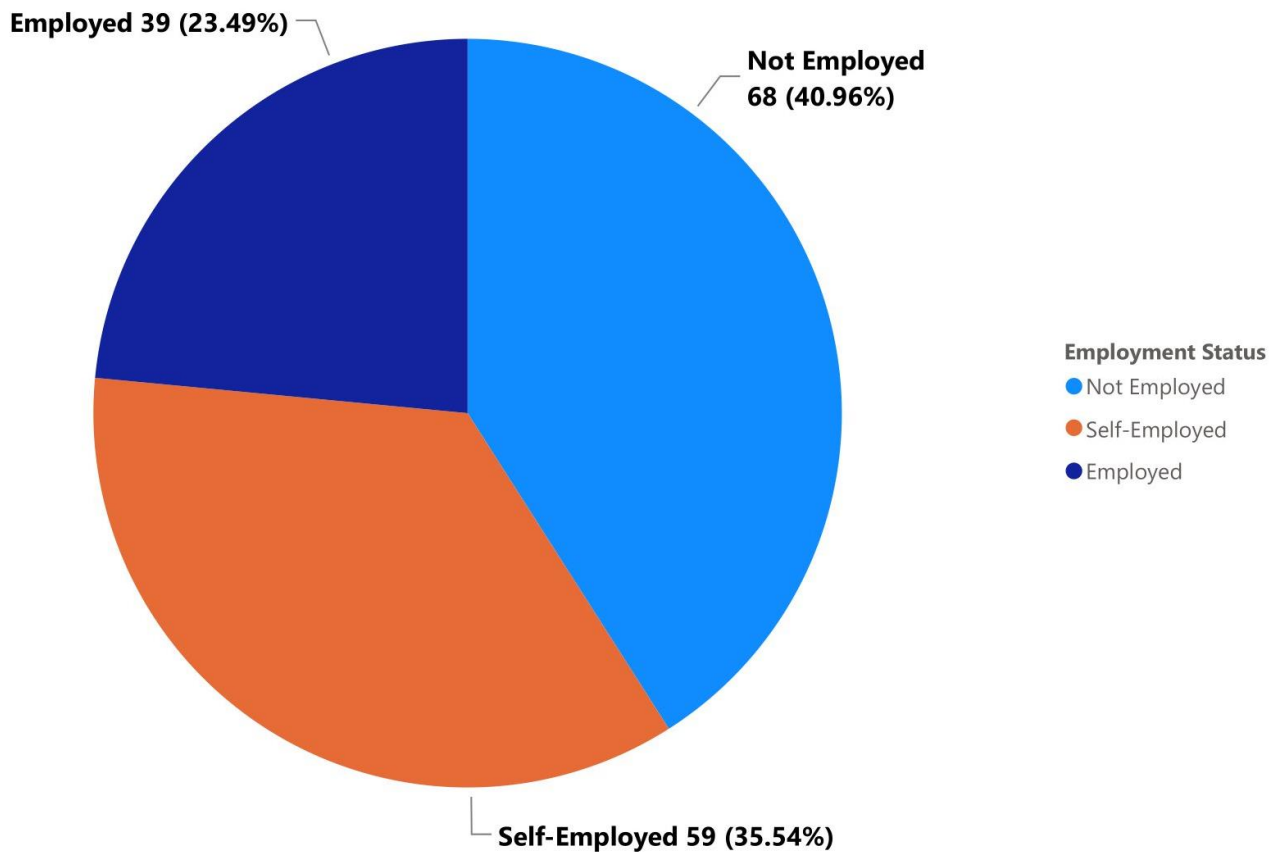

GITL Trainees Employment Status 2022 and 2023

- **23.49% Employment:** More than twenty percent of participants are currently employed, reflecting the practical skills and knowledge gained from GITL's programs.
- **35.54% Business Establishment:** more than thirty percent of participants have taken the entrepreneurial route, establishing their businesses. This achievement signifies the effectiveness of GITL in nurturing self-sufficiency and enterprise among women and girls.
- **40.96% Actively Seeking Employment:** The remaining 40.96% are actively seeking employment, underscoring GITL's commitment to supporting participants in their career journeys.

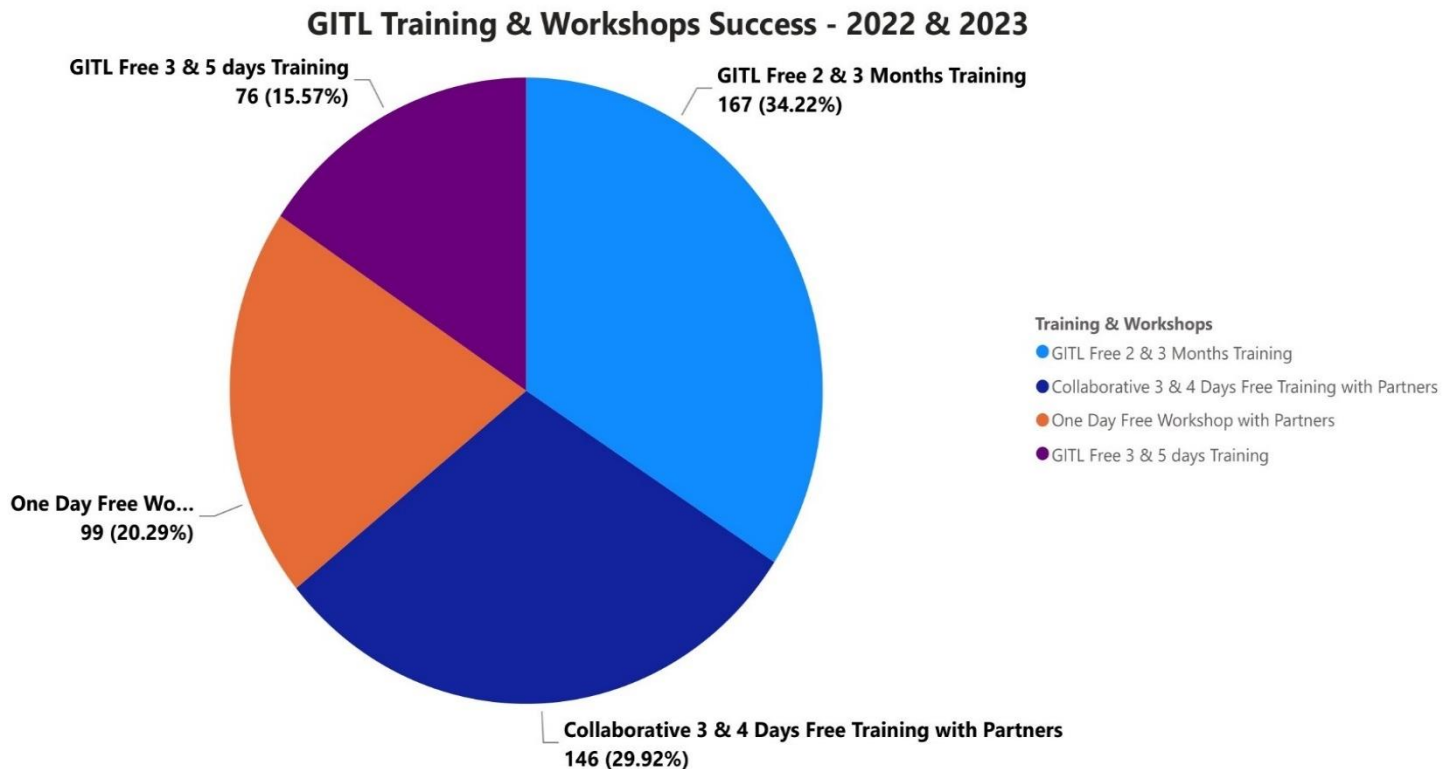
GITL Trainees Employment Status 2022 & 2023
